Emergency Responder Rehabilitation and Incident Support (6651)

Macungie Ambulance Corps operates a dedicated support unit for area Firefighters and other Emergency Responders on physically and emotionally demanding incidents.

The stress experienced by responders during emergencies can be extreme, both physically and mentally. The needs of these responders are unique and can be difficult to appropriately address with the equipment readily available on a normally equipped EMS unit. The purpose of this special operations unit is to bridge the gap between normal EMS care and a dedicated canteen service while providing a standardized approach to rehab.

This unit can be requested at **any time** by any emergency response agency within **Lehigh County** and surrounding areas. **Macungie Ambulance Rehab** is meant to supplement the EMS units already operating on the scene; not replace them. Members responding with the unit are knowledgeable in rehab theory and practice and will provide the equipment and supplies needed for proper emergency incident rehabilitation.

In addition we carry equipment and supplies which may be used to aid in successful incident mitigation. We strive to provide excellent logistical support for any type of incident we are called to.

Terrain Response Vehicle (6653)

The **Terrain Response Vehicle** (pictured on back cover) is a Kubota RTV with an E-Muvr Ambulance package designed to provide **Basic or Advanced Life Support Care** while transporting a patient on a standard ambulance stretcher over difficult or remote terrain. It can also be used to move manpower and equipment.
